# **Montfortian Formation Programme**





Inspired by Pope John Paul II's invitation to promote the Montfortian spirituality and charism as well as the central administration's desire to strengthen the synergy of the Montfortian Charismatic Family, Montfort Centre (Singapore) responded by organising its inaugural Montfortian Formation Programme (MFP).

The MFP was held in Montfort Centre, Singapore from 24 to 27 Aug 2023 with Bishop Rozario Menezes, SMM as the main preacher and animator. A total of 26 participants (lay associates and religious) from across 4 countries (Indonesia, Philippines, Sabah & Singapore) took part in this significant event. It was beautiful to witness both the lay associates Montfortian Gabrielite Associates and religious

(Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel & Montfort Missionaries) coming together as a Montfortian Charismatic family to deepen and grow their understanding and appreciation of Montfortian spirituality. It was most unfortunate though that the Daughters of Wisdom and Friends of Wisdom were unable to join this time round.

As the current serving bishop of the diocese of Lae, Papua New Guinea, Bishop Rozario generously shared many personal stories from his mission in Papua New Guinea and how the spirituality of Montfort only began to make sense in his lived experience as a missionary. He further reminded participants that no one is chosen by chance but because God has a special plan for each one. He challenged the participants to consider how their own vocation story reveals God's unceasing love for them all these while. The six sessions presented by Bishop Rozario were on:

- 1. Gift of Life Birth & Baptism at Montfort
- 2. Trust in God Surrender to God's Providence
- 3. Poverty and Service to Humanity The poor in the life of Montfort and his service to them

- 4. Prayer, Contemplation & Creation A way to God
- 5. Cross of Christ & mine How do I see suffering in my personal life
- 6. Mary my Mother A True & Loving Marian Devotion

Montfortian prayers such as the Little Crown of Mary, Praise to Mary and Adoration with the Rosary according to Montfort were animated by the Montfortian Gabrielite Associates from Sabah and Singapore. Participants also had lively conversations and fellowship over meals as they discussed how to further collaborate with one another at a Southeast Asian level.



# **Moulded by Mary**

'Moulded by Mary' is a day retreat with prayer, candle making, and fellowship run by the Montfortian Gabrielite Associates. The event has been run 3 times: on 21 October 2023 and 9 December 2023 at Montfort Centre, and on 6 January 2024 at Church of the Sacred Heart

As written by St Louis Marie de Montfort, Mary is a mould capable of forming people into the image of the God-man. Anyone who is cast into this divine mould is quickly shaped and moulded into Jesus and Jesus into him. Through this retreat, the participants were also invited to reflect on which parts of them need to be crushed and liquified so that they can be poured into the Mould of Jesus, in order to become like the image of Jesus.

'By the Light of Mary's Crown: The Tree of Life' was an evening of reflection, prayer and fellowship conducted by MGA Brian Ooi in Montfort Centre on 2 December 2023 from 7.00pm to 10.00pm. The session began with an opening prayer and a brief introduction with 10 enthusiastic participants after dinner. MGA Cynthia together with MGA Edward and MGA Henry came as volunteers to prepare a warm and inviting setting using tealights around the Labyrinth Walk, Montfort Garden, Chapel and Mervent Cave.

Brian started by explaining the meaning of 'The Crown of Mary'. Mary's Crown bears witness to the first coming of Jesus Christ, the New Adam. Thereafter, he shared about the 'The Two Trees', taken from Genesis 2:9: The Tree of Life and the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil. The Tree of Life as a choice was then aptly summarized by Brian through the illustration below, contrasting the 'Old Adam and Eve' with the 'New Adam and Eve (Jesus and Mary)'.

All 10 participants were then given an hour for personal reflection and prayer in the grounds of Montfort Centre. Many chose to Walk the Labyrinth under a clear night sky as it was beautifully illuminated with tealights. It was the first time for some of the participants.

The participants then shared their personal reflections, insights and encounter with the

Lord from the session and during the Labyrinth Walk. Brian then closed the session with a simple message and beautiful prayer. He said, "Blessed is Jesus, fruit of Mary. The Holy Spirit plants the Tree of Life, Mary in our souls, that we may bear the fruit of her womb, Jesus." He then invited the participants to pray together, "Happy is that soul in which Mary, the Tree of Life, is planted. Happier still is the soul in which she has been able to grow and blossom. Happier again is the soul in which she brings forth her fruit. But happiest of all is the soul which savours the sweetness of Mary's fruit and preserves it up till death and then beyond to all eternity. Amen."



## **Christmas Celebration 2023**



The celebration was held on Wed 27 December at Montfort Centre. What better way to start the celebration than to pay homage to the Child Jesus with a special Christmas Prayer with Montfort.
