Since the pandemic, the anxiety and stress levels of people in Singapore, including caregivers, teachers and children have been at an all-time high. Singapore is also seeing a surge in mental health issues among youths and is working with researchers to better understand the root causes.

Spirituality influences many decisions that people make. Christian Spirituality in particular helps people to have a holistic understanding about themselves, others, and God. In this sense, it helps people cope better with stress by recognising that there is meaning in suffering and that God is even closer when one is experiencing deep distress.

As such, Montfort Centre organised two spirituality and mentalwellbeing recollection days; one for the public (Fully Human, Fully Alive - 27 Apr) and the other especially for educators (Peace of Mind - 1 Jul). During the recollection, participants were provided with some points for prayer and reflection before finding their own quiet corners within the tranquil spaces of Montfort Centre and receiving the peace of Christ.
